- The annual report of the Global Hunger Index (GHI) for 2023 has arrived, India is at number 111 among 125 countries.
- India has been described as a country with a serious situation of hunger with a GHI score of 28.7.
- India is ranked 107th among 121 countries in the 2022 ranking.
- According to the report of the Global Hunger Index, the rate of malnutrition (undernutrition) in India has increased to 16.6 percent & the mortality rate of children under five years of age (child mortality rate) is 3.1 percent.
- According to the report, the rate of anaemia among women aged
 15 to 24 years in India has increased to 58.1 percent.
- India's neighbouring countries Pakistan (102nd), Bangladesh (81st),
 Nepal (69th) and Sri Lanka (60th) are ahead of India.
- The top 20 countries of this ranking include Belarus, Bosnia & Herzegovina, China, Hungary, Estonia etc.
- Central African Republic (125), Madagascar (124) and Yemen (123) are at the bottom of the ranking.
- The Government of India has rejected this year's report & described the methodology for preparing the report as inaccurate and misleading.
