

PM e-Bus Sewa Scheme

- Recently the Union Cabinet has appointed PM e-Bus Sewa scheme has been approved.
- Augmenting city bus services: 10,000 e-buses will be introduced on the Public-Private Partnership (PPP) model.





- Green Urban Mobility Initiatives: Green initiatives such as priority to buses, infrastructure, multi-modal interchange facilities, etc. have been envisaged.
- Cities with a population of three lakh and above as per the 2011 census will be covered.





- Preference will be given to those cities where there is no organized bus service.
- Duration: The scheme will support the operation of buses for a period of 10 years.



India's First — 3D Printed Post Office

- Union Minister Ashwini Vaishnav recently inaugurated the country's first 30-printed post office in Bangalore.
- It has been manufactured by Larsen & Toubro Limited in technical collaboration with IIT Madras.



- This post office is India's first 3D-printed post office located in Cambridge Layout, Bengaluru.
- It has been constructed using 3D concrete printing technology, a fully automated building construction technology.





- The project mainly consists of machines and robots, which are indigenous.
- This technology was imported from Denmark for the post office project.
- The 30-printing technology enables weather-proofing and the inclusion of utilities within the walls.
- The unique concrete material used for this project provides pumpability,





- extrudability, and buildability and is characterized by mechanical properties.
- The overarching goal of building a 3D-printed post office is to explore the utility of 3D printing technology in housing.


