



The BRICS grouping of India, Russia, China, Brazil and South Africa has expanded.The Johannesburg Summit of BRICS announced the inclusion of six new countries Argentina, Egypt, Ethiopia, Iran, Saudi Arabia and the UAE.

These countries will join the group from January 1, 2024.

After this expansion, the share of BRICS countries in the global gross domestic product (Global GDP) will be 26 percent.

The expansion of BRICS aims to emerge as a counterweight to the Western-dominated global order.

The theme of the 15th BRICS Summit is "BRICS and Africa: A Partnership for Mutually Accelerated Growth, Sustainable Development and Inclusive Multilateralism".





BRICS is an acronym for the grouping of the world's leading emerging economies – Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa.

In 2001, British economist Jim O'Neill coined the term BRIC to describe the four emerging economies of Brazil, Russia, India and China.

The grouping was formalized during the first meeting of BRIC Foreign Ministers in 2006.

In December 2010, South Africa was invited to join BRIC, after which the grouping adopted the acronym BRICS.

The chairmanship of the Forum is rotated annually amona the members. as per B-R-I-C-S.

India hosted the chairmanship of the 2021 BRICS summit.







India's Rameshbabu Praggnanandhaa suffered a thrilling defeat in the final of the Chess World Cup 2023 against world No.1 Grandmaster Magnus Carlsen.

In the final, Praggnanandhaa gave a tough fight to Carlsen but India's Red lost in the tie-breaker.

The first tie-breaker between the two was a draw but in the second tie-breaker, Carlsen easily won the title over Praggnanandhaa.

Praggnanandhaa won quarterfinal and semifinal matches against world No. 2 Hikaru Nakamura and world No. 3 Fabiano Caruana.

Praggnanandhaa was the youngest-ever World Cup finalist, and the youngest ever World Cup winner.





Praggnanandhaa became the world champion in the Airthings Masters rapid chess tournament by defeating Carlsen in a rapid game.

Praggnanandhaa, seeded 31st, is also the lowest seeded player to make it to the final of the World

The Chess World Cup 2023 is organized by the International Chess Federation (FIDE), the governing body of chess in the world. It has been formed as a non-governmental organization.





FIDE is currently headquartered in Lausanne (Switzerland), but was initially founded in Paris in 1924 under the motto "Gens Una Sumus" (Latin for "We Are One Family").


26th National Conference e-Governance
