The Union Home Ministry has extended AFSPA for another 6 months in Manipur, Nagaland and parts of Arunachal Pradesh.

Under AFSPA, the armed forces have been given special powers to restore law and order in disturbed areas.

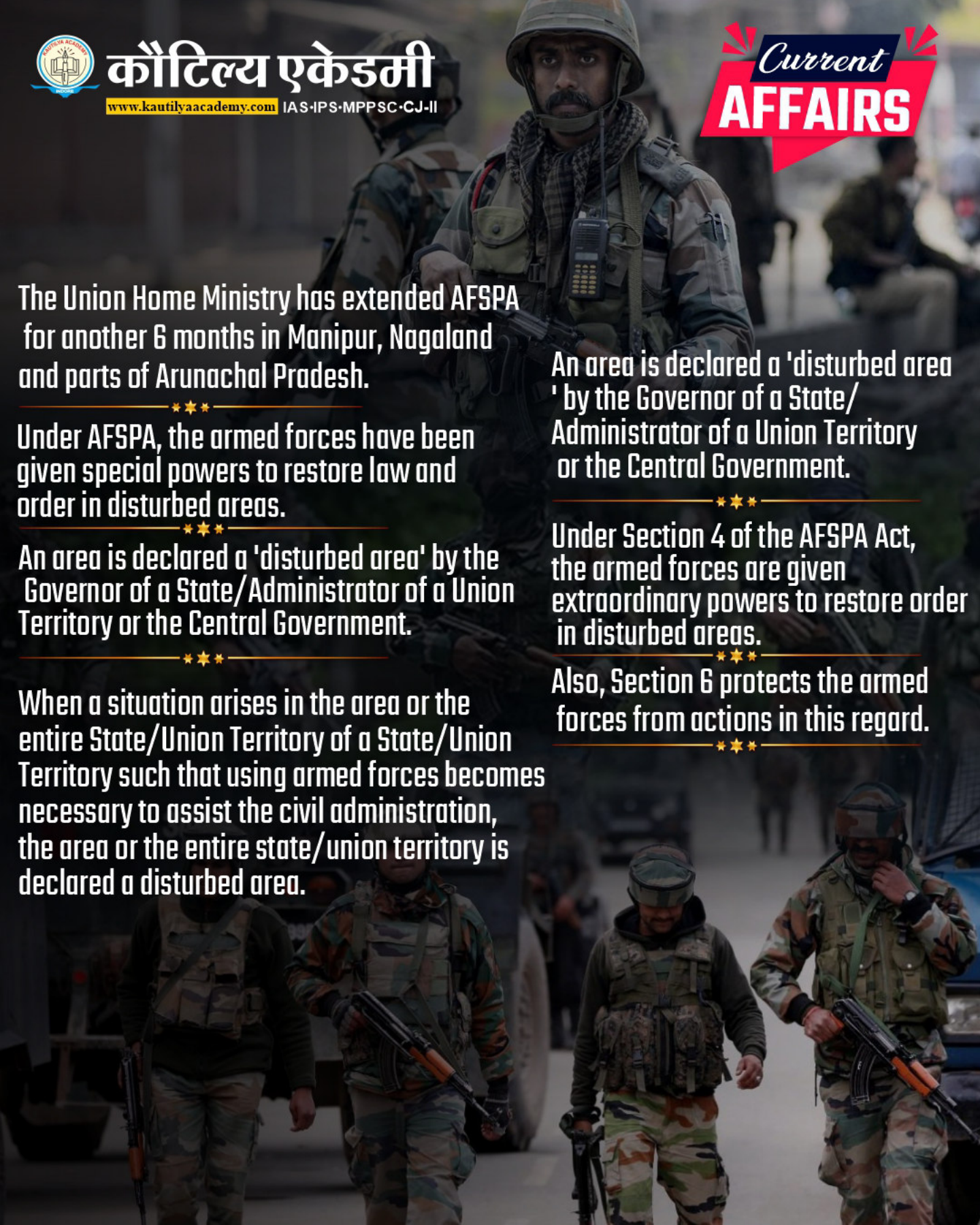
An area is declared a 'disturbed area' by the Governor of a State/Administrator of a Union Territory or the Central Government.

When a situation arises in the area or the entire State/Union Territory of a State/Union Territory such that using armed forces becomes necessary to assist the civil administration, the area or the entire state/union territory is declared a disturbed area.

An area is declared a 'disturbed area' by the Governor of a State/Administrator of a Union Territory or the Central Government.

Under Section 4 of the AFSPA Act, the armed forces are given extraordinary powers to restore order in disturbed areas.

Also, Section 6 protects the armed forces from actions in this regard.

The Income Tax Department has notified new angel tax rules related to the valuation of shares issued by startup companies to investors.

Changes in Rule 11UA of the Income Tax Act provide that valuation of compulsorily non-debenture shares, and equity shares issued by unlisted startups can also be based on fair market value.

Angel tax is levied when an unlisted company issue shares to an investor at a price higher than the fair market value.

Earlier, it was levied only on investments of resident investors.

However, in the Budget 2023-24, it has been proposed to impose it on non-resident investors also from April 1, 2024.
