





South Asia remains the region with the worst average GTI score in the world.

The world's deadliest terrorist group, Islamic State (IS), in 2022; Al-Shabaab; Balochistan Liberation Army (BLA) and Jamaat Nusrat al-Islam Wal Muslimeen (JNIM).

The report lists the Communist Party of India (Maoist) as the 12th deadliest terrorist group in 2022.

Global Terrorism Index (GTI):- A comprehensive study analyzing the impact of terrorism on 163 countries covering 99.7 percent of the world's population.

GTI scores each country on a scale of O to 10; Where O represents no impact from terrorism and 10 represents the highest measurable impact of terrorism.



Recently TRAI has issued a consultation paper on 'Regulatory Mechanism for Over-the-Top (OTT) Communication Services and Regarding Selective Ban on OTT Services.

Due to this, the debate has again erupted regarding net neutrality.

Net neutrality is a principle advocating a free and level playing field for all online content and services.

Net Neutrality

This principle ensures that Internet service providers (ISPs) treat everyone equally without discriminating or charging differently based on the content, its source, or its destination.

The Department of Telecommunications (DoT) issued a regulatory framework on net neutrality in 2018.

It supports the principle of nondiscrimination with some exceptions.

The report of caste-based census has been released in Bihar.

Bihar's Additional Chief Secretary Vivek Singh has presented the caste census figures.

Bihar has become the first state to release caste census data.


According to the caste survey, the total population of Bihar is around 13 crores.

According to the report, backward class is 27.12 percent, extremely backward class is 36.01 percent, scheduled caste is 19.65 percent, scheduled tribe is 1.68 percent and unreserved i.e. upper caste is 15.52 percent.

In the population of the state, the number of people living outside Bihar is 53 lakh 72 thousand 22.

According to calculations, there are 953 women for every 1000 men.

The caste census started in Bihar in January 2023.







The announcement of the winners' names of the world's most prestigious Nobel Prize started on Monday.

Awards will be announced for six days.

It began with the announcement of the names of the winners in the field of medicine.

Catalin Carico and Drew Weissman have received the Nobel Prize in Medicine.

This prestigious award has been conferred for his discoveries related to nucleoside base modifications.

Their discovery helped lead to the development of effective mRNA vaccines against COVID-19.

This happened for the first time during Corona, when Pfizer, Bio N Tech and Moderna made a vaccine based on mRNA technology.





Katalin Kariko (Hungary) -

- •Born on 17 January 1955 in Hungary.
- Worked on RNA at the Szeged University of Hungary.
- He worked on mRNA technology at the University of Pennsylvania.

Drew Weissman (USA)-

- Drew is a famous immunologist.
- In 2005, Drew and Kariko published a research paper claiming that immunity can be increased through modified mRNA.

Nobel Prize-

- First given 1901
- Fields Physics, Chemistry, Medicine, Literature, Economics and Peace.
- Prize money 11 million Swedish currency crowns (Rs eight crore ten lakh)
- This award is given in the name of Alfred Nobel.
- Alfred Nobel was the inventor of dynamite.
- Nobel Prizes have been presenting to Nobel Prize laureates at ceremonies on 10 December.
- All awards except the Nobel Peace Prize are given in Sweden.
- The Nobel Peace Prize is awarded in Norway.
- The prize in economic sciences was established by Sveriges Riksbank in 1968 but was first awarded in 1969.
