Sriramana Kali Temple

Role - Recently, the Sri Ramana Kali temple located in Bangladesh was inaugurated by the President of India, Shri Ram Nath Kovind.

Exam Useful Points -

- This temple was destroyed by the Pakistan Army in Operation Searchlight in 1971.
- Operation Searchlight launched in 1971 to protest a Bengali nationalist movement in East Pakistan (Bangladesh). In which more than a thousand people died.
- This temple is built in Dhaka during the time of Mughal Empire.
- It was near the Suharvardi garden in Dhaka. In Nepalese legends the Ramana Kali temple was established by the devotees of Goddess Kali. The devotees had come to Bengal from the Himalayas.
- This temple was extensively developed in the early 20th century.
- This temple was developed under the patronage of Vilasmoni Devi, wife of Rajendra Narayan.
- There was a Dighi (pool) in front of the temple which was a popular place for devotees to swim.



- Next to the temple there is Anandmoi Ashram.
- This temple is built in Nagar style.
- This temple was rebuilt by the Government of India. The inauguration was done by the Indian President Shri Ram Nath Kovind on the occasion of 50th Vijay Diwas.

Parvovirus

- It is a highly contagious disease that affects puppies and dogs.
- It is a zoonotic disease, meaning it can affect humans from animals as well.
- This virus was first discovered in 1967.
- This can be done through direct contact with an infected dog or through indirect contact with a milky object. There is no vaccine yet to stop the leaking.

Exam Useful Points -

- In the Panama Papers link case, there were legal documents of a company "Mossack Fonseca", which got linked.
- This data was released by the German newspaper 'Suddeutsche Zeitung' on 3 April 2016.
- In this, the names of politicians, businessmen, celebrities from 200 countries including India were included, on which money laundering was done. It contained information from 1977 to the end of 2015.
- The list also includes the names of many Indian politicians, celebrity businessmen.
- Panama is a transcontinental country bordered by Costa Rica to the west, Colombia to the southeast, the Caravian Sea to the north, and the Pacific Ocean to the south.
- The Panama Canal connects the Caribbean Sea to the Gulf of Panama (Pacific Ocean).
