- AERA:- It is a regulatory agency that regulates tariffs and other expenses and charges of major airports in India and India.
- This statutory body is governed by the Airports Economic Regulatory Act of India was established in 2008.
- UDAN means common citizen of 35 countries. It is a regional airport development and regional connectivity scheme.
- The bill was introduced by Civil Aviation Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia and was passed in the Lok Sabha in June 2021.
