- Hunar Haat is an exhibition of handicrafts and traditional products made by artisans from minority communities.
- It envisages to promote the skills of artisans, weavers and artisans who are already engaged in traditional ancestral work.
- The 75th haat to be held across the country will be part of the Amrit Mahotsav and mark the occasion of 75 years of India's independence.

- These are organized under the Scheme for Upgradation of Skills and Training in Traditional Arts/Crafts for Development by the Ministry of Minority Affairs.
- The objective of the USTTAD scheme is to promote and preserve the rich heritage of traditional crafts and crafts of minority communities.
- Hunar Haat has proved to be a medium of empowerment for skilled artisans and craftsmen.
- It has proved to be extremely fulfilling and encouraging for the artisans and craftsmen.

Role:- Recently the Government of India has announced the launch of National Hydrogen Mission. It aims to make India a global hub for production and export of green hydrogen.

Exam Useful Points:-

- Hydrogen is the lightest and first element in the periodic table, since hydrogen is lighter than air.
- In general, hydrogen is a non-toxic non-metallic, odourless, tasteless, colorless and highly flammable diatomic gas.
- The only by-product emitted from the use of hydrogen fuel is water. Therefore, this fuel is considered 100% clean.
- It is used in fuel cells or internal combustion engines.
- Hydrogen fuel is also used in spacecraft propulsion.
- It is the most abundant element found in the universe. The Sun and other stars are largely composed of hydrogen.
- We also need to note that for the commercial use of hydrogen as a fuel and in industries, the production, storage, transportation and demand generation of hydrogen requires huge investment in research and development.

Exam Useful Points:-

- He was the creator of the popular number puzzle Sudoku. His moistness was spreading the joy of riddles.
- He was born on October 8, 1951 in Sapporo, Hokkaido. His father was an engineer in a telecommunications company, while his mother was an employer in a kimonie shop.
- He did his education from Shakuni High School in Shapar. He later studied literature at Keio University, but dropped out in his first year.
- Nikoji was a quarterly puzzle magazine of Kazi. Manganese was named after a race horse. Who won the Guinness Stakes Race in Ireland.
- Sudoku is a logic based combinatorial number placement puzzle. The Puzzle Centre provides a partially complete grid, for which a well-formed puzzle has only one solution.
- Maki was the chairman of Kazi Nikoli Company Limited. This is a Japanese puzzle maker. He was popularly called the father of Sudoku as he was instrumental in popularizing the number game.
- He recently resigned as head of Nikoli before his death in July 2021.

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
