






Katchatheevu Island

- Recently, Katchatheevu Island is situated between Sri Lanka and **Tamil Nadu,** due to which politics is quite heated these days.
- The PM alleged that the Congress (former PM Indira Gandhi during the Congress rule) had cut off a part of Maa Bharati by calling the Katchatheevu a useless island, which is very important from the security point of view between Sri Lanka and Tamil Nadu,




















Katchatheevu Island dispute?

- Katchatheevu Island, a green area of about 285 acres, was a part/part of India till 1976.
- Fishermen from both the countries have been fishing in each other's waters for a very long time without any dispute. The issue emerged when the two countries signed four maritime boundary agreements between 1974–76.
- In the year 1974, the then PM Indira Gandhi had signed four maritime boundary agreements with Sri Lankan President Srimavo Bandaranaike between 1974-76.


















- However, the resolution was passed by the Tamil Nadu Assembly in 1991. In this there was a demand to take back this island.
- In 2008, the then CM Jayalalitha had filed a petition in the Supreme Court. The petition demanded that the agreement regarding Katchatheevu island be declared invalid.
- It was said in the petition that gifting Katchatheevu to Sri Lanka is unconstitutional.
- In May 2022, Tamil Nadu Chief Minister MK Stalin had demanded the central government to reclaim Katchatheevu island to India.





















Location of Katchatheevu Island:

- Katchatheevu is a 285-acre uninhabited place in the Palk Strait between India and Sri Lanka.
- At its widest point it is no more than 1.6 km long and a little over 300 m wide.
- It is located north-east of Rameshwaram, about 33 km from the Indian coast.
- It is about 62 km south-west of Jaffna, on the northern tip of Sri Lanka, and 24 km

from the inhabited Delft Island of Sri Lanka.





















History of Katchatheevu Island:

- Katchatheevu Island was formed due to a volcanic eruption in the 14th century.
- It was once under the rule of Raja Ramanad/Ramnad of Madurai in the 17th century.
- During British rule the island came under Madras Presidency.
- In 1921, both Sri Lanka and India claimed this land for fishing but the dispute remained unresolved. After independence it was considered a part of India.





















Miami Open 2024

- Recently, Indian tennis star Rohan Bopanna and his Australian partner Matthew **Ebden** won the Miami Open 2024 tennis men's doubles title at the **Hard Rock** Stadium in Florida.
- At the age of 44, Bopanna has become the oldest player to win the ATP Masters 1000 title.





















- In Miami Open 2024, the pair of **Bopanna** and **Ebdon** have defeated Ivan Dodik of Croatia and Austin Krajicek of US.
- Bopanna and Ebden defeated second seeds Ivan Dodig and Austin Krajicek 6-7 (3), 6-3, 10-6 in a thrilling match that lasted one hour and 42 minutes in Miami.
- This was Bopanna's 14th ATP Masters 1000 final. This was the 63rd ATP Tour level final and 26th doubles title for this experienced Indian player.
- The pair of Bopanna and Ebdon won the men's doubles title in the Australian Open 2024.






















Miami Open (tennis):
