REACHOUT Scheme

- Research, Education and Training Outreach.
- Launch – Ministry of Earth Sciences
- Start – March 2023
- Objective – To encourage research, education and training in the field of Earth Sciences.

● Mahila Samman Savings Certificate Scheme

- Launch – Department of Posts
- Start – 1 April 2023
- The announcement was made by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman during Budget 2023-24
- Objective - In this scheme, any Indian woman or girl can open her account in post offices and get a fixed interest of 7.5% per annum from Rs 1000/- to a maximum of Rs 2 lakh/-.

● PRIP plan

- Promotion of Research & Innovation in Pharma-MedTech sector
- Launch – Ministry of Health
- Start – September 2023
- Objective – To enhance the capacity of Public Sector Undertakings and encourage private sector participation in research The Government believes that the Indian pharmaceutical industry has the potential to increase the global market share from the current 3.4 per cent to 5 per cent by 2030.

Mission on Advanced and High-Impact Research

- Launch – Ministry of Power and Ministry of New and Renewable Energy
- Start – 2023 (duration 5 years)
- Objective – To identify and develop emerging technologies in the power sector within and outside India

● Credit Guarantee Scheme

- Launch – Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and Small Industries
- Development Bank of India (SIDBI)
- Start – 2023 (duration 5 years)
- Objective – Central Government to revive rural economy and empower MSMEs enterprises

● Vivad Se Vishwas-2 Scheme

- Launch – The scheme was announced by Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman in the Union Budget 2023-24
- Objective – It is a voluntary settlement scheme to resolve long-standing contractual disputes involving government agencies.



● National Quantum Mission

■ Inauguration – Union Cabinet

■ On April 19, the National Quantum Mission has been approved for 2023-24 to 2030-31 with a total cost of Rs 6,003.65 crore.

■ Objective – National Quantum Mission will help in scientific and industrial research and development work

● New Swamima Scheme

■ Launch - National Backward Classes Finance and Development Corporation

■ Start – February, 2023

■ Objective - All backward-class women will get a loan of ₹ 2,00,000 for business. Only 5% annual interest rate will have to be paid on this loan.

● Amrit Bharat Station Scheme

■ Launch – By Prime Minister Narendra Modi

■ Start – February, 2023

■ This scheme is under the Ministry of Railways

Objective – This includes modernizing the stations, expanding passenger facilities, managing passengers and creating better sign systems.

● Vibrant Villages Programme

- Launch – Union Home Minister Amit Shah launched the Vibrant Village Program from Kibithu in Arunachal Pradesh.
- Start – 15th February 2023
- Objective – Under the Vibrant Village Programme, the Central Government is working to empower the border villages. To connect these villages with government road connectivity, drinking water, electricity including solar and wind energy, mobile and internet connectivity, tourism centres, multi-purpose centres and health infrastructure and health wellness centres.

● Lakhpati Didi Scheme

- Launch – Prime Minister Narendra Modi
- Start – 15 August 2023 (Independence Day) Red Fort (New Delhi)
This scheme is under the Rural Development Department
- Objective – Under this scheme, the government will provide financial assistance to women so that they can further pursue their industry and work and also improve the economic condition of women.

- Inauguration – Prime Minister Narendra Modi
- Done on duty in New Delhi on 31st October 2023
- About My Youth India (MY India) -
- My Youth India (MY India), an autonomous body, which will provide a proper platform to the youth to showcase their talents and fulfill their dreams, so that they can play a leading role in building a developed India.

PM e-Bus Sewa

- Launch – 16 August 2023
- Objective – To increase urban transport efficiency and promote eco-friendly practices, through this scheme 10,000 electric buses will be operated under the
- Public-Private Partnership (PPP) model in more than 100 cities.

● Mera Bill Mera Adhikaar' Scheme

- Launch – Ministry of Finance
- Start – 1 September 2023
- This scheme has been started as a pilot project.

Objective - To motivate more and more people to take GST bills. This scheme will also prove to be very effective so that the government can crack down on tax evasion. Apart from this, the income of the government will also increase through this scheme.



● PM-USHA Scheme

- Pradhan Mantri Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan
- Launch – RUSA (Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan) scheme has been renamed as Pradhan Mantri Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (PM-USHA Scheme) (a centrally sponsored scheme) in June 2023
- Objective – To enhance quality in higher education institutions, ensure compliance with norms and accreditation standards, promote governance and academic reforms and encourage research and innovation.

● PM PRANAM SCHEME

- Prime Minister Program for Restoration, Awareness, Nourishment and Amelioration of Mother Earth
- Inauguration – Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman while presenting the budget for the financial year 2023-24
- Commencement – Cabinet approval received on 28 June 2023
- Objective - Its objective is to reduce the subsidy burden on the government and promote alternative fertilizers in place of chemical fertilizers in farming.

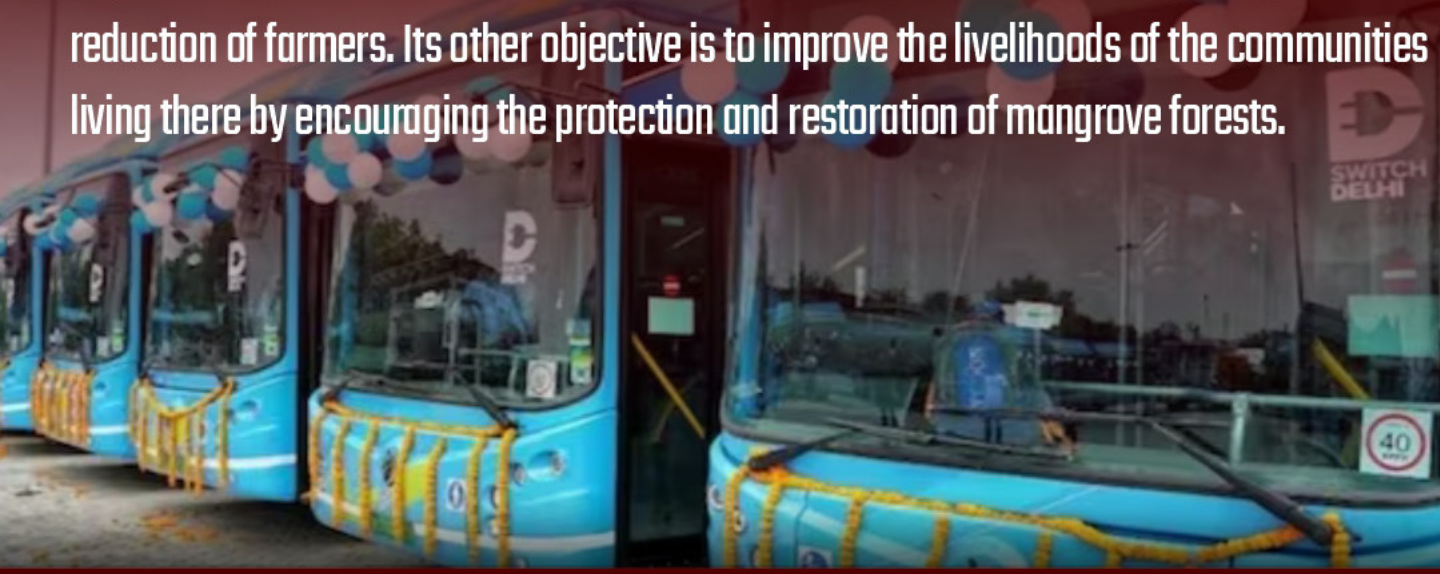


● Amrit Dharohar Scheme

- Duration of the scheme – for next 3 years
- Launch – Prime Minister Narendra Modi
- Beginning – 5th June 2023 (World Environment Day)
- Objective – To encourage maximum use of wetlands and enhance biodiversity, carbon stock, ecotourism opportunities and income generation for local communities.

● MISHTI (Mishti) Scheme

- Mangrove Initiative for Shoreline Habitats & Tangible Incomes
- Launch – Prime Minister Narendra Modi
- Onset – 5th June 2023 (World Environment Day)
- Objective – To solve the twin challenges of conservation of forests and poverty reduction of farmers. Its other objective is to improve the livelihoods of the communities living there by encouraging the protection and restoration of mangrove forests.





● PM Vishwakarma Scheme

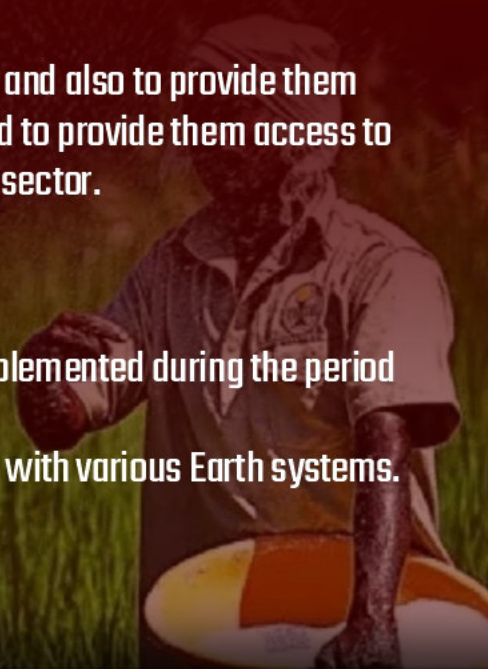
- Launch – Prime Minister Narendra Modi
- Start – This scheme has been started in New Delhi on 17 September 2023 (on the occasion of Vishwakarma Jayanti).
- Objective - Central Government will provide 8 percent subsidy on loans to artisans under 'Vishwakarma Yojana'

● NAMASTE SCHEME

- National Action Plan for Mechanized Sanitation Ecosystem
- Launched – Jointly by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs and the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment
- Start – August 2022
- Objective – To reduce the vulnerabilities of sanitation workers and also to provide them access to alternative livelihood support and empowerment and to provide them access to self-employment and employment opportunities in the skilled sector.

● PRITHVI SCHEME

- Beginning – Ministry of Earth Sciences
- PRITHvi Vigyan (PRITHVI) scheme has been approved to be implemented during the period 2021-26.
- Objective – To revolutionize our understanding and interaction with various Earth systems.
- Start Date - 5 January 2024





● Pradhan Mantri Suryoday Yojana

- Start – 22 January 2024
- Eligibility – This scheme will be mainly for low-income and middle-class families and the applicant must be a permanent resident of India with age above 18 years.
- Objective – To install solar panels on the rooftops of more than 1 crore Indian homes.

● PM Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana

- Launch – Prime Minister Narendra Modi
- Start – January 1, 2023
- In November 2023, the Central Government has announced the extension of this scheme till December 2028.
- The scheme is being operated by the Department of Food and Public Distribution, but the nodal ministry is the Finance Ministry.
- Objective – Under this scheme, the Center provides 5 kg of free grains per month to the poor.

● “One Vehicle One Fastag” Initiative

- Launch – National Highway Authority of India
- Start – January 2024
- Objective – To prevent the use of one FASTag for multiple vehicles or linking of multiple FASTags to a single vehicle.
