





Major Schemes of Madhya Pradesh

Tantya Mama Arthik Kalyan Scheme

- Tantya Mama Arthik Kalyan Scheme
- Launch 6 September 2022 Objective:-
 - To provide loans at low interest to the beneficiaries of the Scheduled Tribe category for setting up new enterprises.
 - Under this scheme, financial assistance ranging from Rs 10 thousand to Rs 1 lakh is given.
 - The age of the applicant should be between 18 to 55 years.

Sant Ravidas Self Employment Scheme

- Launch 2022
- Objective:-
 - Loan at low interest for self-employment to Scheduled Caste beneficiaries.
 - Under this scheme, financial assistance ranging from Rs 1 lakh to Rs 50 lakh will be provided in the industry sector and Rs 1 lakh to Rs 25 lakh in the service and business sector.
 - Age group 18 to 40 years











Bhagwan Birsa Munda Self Employment Scheme

- Launch 6 September 2022
- Obiective:-
 - Loan at low interest for self-employment to Scheduled Tribe beneficiaries.
 - Under this scheme, the subsidy will be given on term and working capital loans from the bank at the rate of 5 percent per annum on the condition of regular loan repayment for a maximum of 7 years.
- Financial assistance:-
 - Through this scheme, industrial manufacturing units will get financial assistance ranging from Rs 1 lakh to Rs 50 lakh.
 - Financial assistance ranging from Rs 1 lakh to Rs 25 lakh will be available for the service and retail husiness sector.
 - Beneficiary age group 18 to 45 years

Chief Minister Ladli Behna Yojana

- Start 15 March 2023
- Objective Women Empowerment
- Eligibility: An amount of Rs 1,000 per month will be provided to eligible married, widowed and divorced women aged between 21 to 60 years.
 - The government has announced to provide of Rs 1250 monthly to each beneficiary of MP Ladli Behna Yoiana.

Under this scheme, an amount of Rs 60,000 crore will be allocated among the eligible sisters in 5 years by the Madhya Pradesh government.













Chief Minister Seekho Aur Kamao

- Launch: August 22, 2023
 - Under the "Mukhyamantri Sikho Kamao Yojana", the unemployed youth of the state will learn the work
 of their choice and will also be given Rs 8 to 10 thousand per month.
 - Applicants passing from 12th to post-graduation will be able to avail the benefit of this scheme.
 - Under "Mukhyamantri Sikho-Kamao Yojana", Rs. 8000 per month will be provided to 12th passed children, Rs. 8500 to ITI passed, Rs. 9000 to diploma holders and Rs. 10000 per month to youth having higher degree.

Domestic Violence Assistance Scheme

- Launch 18 January 2022
- Objective:-
 - To provide financial benefits to women suffering from domestic violence.
 - Girls or women suffering from domestic violence will be given assistance up to Rs. 2 lahks if the damage to any body part is less than 40 per cent and up to Rs. 4 lahks if it is more than 40 percent.

















Deendayal Antyodaya Rasoi Yojana

- Launch:- 7 April 2017
 - Madhya Pradesh government has started Deendayal Antyodaya Rasoi Yojana to provide food to poor people at affordable rates.
 - Under Deendayal Antyodaya Rasoi Yojana, kitchens have been constructed in all the districts of Madhya Pradesh.
 - Nutritious food is available in the Deendayal Rasoi. Under Deendayal Antyodaya Rasoi Yojana, earlier a full meal was available for Rs 10 in all the districts of Madhya Pradesh, but now the same food will be available for Rs 5. Under "Deendayal Antyodaya Rasoi Yojana", operation of 100 kitchen centers was initially started in 52 district headquarters of the state and 6 religious cities of Maihar, Amarkantak, Maheshwar, Omkareshwar, Chitrakoot and Orchha.
 - Now these have been opened in all 52 districts of Madhya Pradesh. Now on 2 September 2023, 66 new centers have been opened.

















Chief Minister Kanyadan Scheme

Launched: April 2006

Assistance for marriage of poor, destitute, widow, abandoned Under this scheme, financial assistance of RS.55000 will be provided to each couple.

Balram Tal Scheme

- launch: -25 May 2007 Objective:-
 - To enrich the availability of surface and underground water.
 - These ponds are built by farmers on their fields and have proved to be very useful for providing life-saving irrigation to crops as well as for groundwater enrichment and charging nearby wells and tube wells.
 - To develop groundwater enrichment and crop irrigation facilities by blocking the maximum amount of water flowing from rain in the fields in the state.











Chief Minister Farmer Welfare Scheme

Launch:- 25 September 2020

On the lines of 'PM Kisan Samman Nidhi', Madhya Pradesh government also started Mukhyamantri Kisan Kalyan Yojana.

Under Mukhyamantri Kisan Kalyan Yojana 2023, RS.4000 was provided to all the farmers. But now this amount has been increased to Rs.6000, due to which all the farmers of Madhya Pradesh will now get Rs.12000 every year.

Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Scheme

- Launch:- 22 January 2015
- Objective:-
 - To ensure education and participation of girls.
 - To ensure the survival and safety of the girl child.
 - Progressive increase in sex ratio.
 - •To improve the situation of child sex ratio and gender imbalance in future.
 - Beti Bachao Beti Padhao scheme aims to enable the girl child and her education.
