- Famous lyricist Gulzar for Urdu and Jagatguru Rambhadracharya for Sanskrit will be given the 58th Jnanpith Award.







Gulzar:-

- विद्वान जगदुरु
- Sampooran Singh Kalra, better known as Gulzar.
- A well-known personality of Hindi cinema and a highly respected Urdu poet.
- Gulzar has received awards for his work including the Sahitya Akademi Award for Urdu in 2002, the Dadasaheb Phalke Award in 2013, the Padma Bhushan in 2004 and at least five National Film Awards.
- The song "Jai Ho" from the film "Slumdog Millionaire", which won an Oscar in 2009 and a Grammy Award in 2010. He has also composed songs for critically acclaimed films like "Maachis" (1996). , "Omkara" (2006), "Dil Se..." (1998), and "Guru" (2007), among others.
- Gulzar has directed evergreen award-winning classics such as "Koshish" (1972),
- "Parichay" (1972), "Mausam" (1975), "Ijaazat" (1977) and the television serial "Mirza Ghalib (1988)".





















- Jagadguru Rambhadracharya stands as a great figure in the world of Sanskrit scholarship and Hindu spirituality.
- As the founder and head of Tulsi Peeth in Madhya Pradesh, his contribution to education, literature and spiritual discourse is unparalleled.
- The author of over 240 books and treatises, including four epics, Rambhadracharya's prolific output spanned a variety of subjects and forms.
- His receipt of Padma Vibhushan in 2015 proves his significant impact on Indian culture and scholarship.
- A polyglot fluent in 22 languages, Rambhadracharya's influence extended across linguistic and communal boundaries, epitomizing the universal appeal of Indian spiritual and literary traditions.





It is the highest award in Indian literature.

This award was established in 1961.

For the first time in 1965, Malayalam poet G. Sankara Kurup was given this award for his work Odakkuzhal.

This award is given only to a citizen of India, who writes in any of the 22 languages mentioned in the Eighth Schedule.

Januard Award





















- The award carries an amount of Rs 11 lakh, a citation and a bronze statue of Vagdevi in the Eighth Schedule.
- In 1976, Bengali novelist, Ashapurna Devi, became the first woman to receive the Jnanpith Award.
- She was Awarded for the novel Pratham Protishruti (The First Promise).
- The first Hindi writer to receive the Jnanpith Award is Sumitranandan Pant.
 - In the year 1968, he was awarded the Jnanpith Award for his work Chidambara.
- For the first time in the year 2018, this award for English literature was given to Amitav Ghosh.



















Cartosat 2









ISRO's Cartosat-2 satellite was brought into the Earth's atmosphere from space.

कन्वेंशन के बारे में:

- It was a satellite of the second generation of high resolution imaging satellites.
- ◆ The satellite entered the Earth's atmosphere over the Indian Ocean on February 14 at 3:48 pm.
- Cartosat-2.-•It was launched in 2007.
 - It was a state-of-the-art remote sensing satellite.
 - It was capable of providing scene-specific spot imagery.










- De-orbiting Cartosat-2: ISRO brought down its perigee by using the remaining fuel.
- Perigee is the point in a satellite's orbit where it is closest to Earth.
- De-orbiting was performed to comply with international guidelines on space debris prevention.
- By de-orbiting Cartosat-2, ISRO has made a significant contribution towards the long-term continuation of outer space related activities.
