- Shankar Mahadevan has received a Grammy in the category of Best Global Music Album for his band 'Shakti"s album 'This moment'.
- Artists like Shankar Mahadevan, Zakir Hussain, V Selvaganesh and Ganesh Rajagopalan work together in Shakti Band.
- Zakir Hussain won this award in 3 categories.











- Zakir Hussain shared the Grammy with flute player Rakesh Chaurasia in the Best Global Music Performance category for 'Pashto'.
- Apart from this, the album 'This Moment' of his band 'Shakti' won the Grammy in the category of Best Global Music Album.
- Ustad Zakir Hussain has won a Grammy in the Contemporary Instrumental Album category for 'As We Speak'.
- The song 'Abundance in Millets' written by PM Modi also got a place in the nomination in the Global Song category at the Grammy Awards 2024.
- PM Modi has written this song with singers Falguni Shah and Gaurav Shah.
- The first Grammy Award in India was received by Pandit Ravi Shankar, famous for his sitar playing, in the year 1968.
- He was awarded this award 5 times, after which he was also given the Life Time Achievement Award by the Grammys in 2013.
- Tanvi Shah is the first Indian woman to win a Grammy in 2008.
- He has sung songs in Tamil, Hindi and Telugu.

Grammy Award –

- It is the biggest award given in the field of music.
- It is named after a gramophone.
- This award was given for the first time on 4 May 1959.
- This award is given by America's 'The Recording Academy'
- The Recording Academy was established in 1957.

















Exemption under RTI Act, 2005

- Recently, the Delhi High Court has ruled that the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) is not completely exempted from disclosing information under RTI as per Section 24 of the Right to Information (RTI) Act.
- Under this, the intelligence and security organizations listed in the Second Schedule of the Act have been exempted from the RTI Act.














- It is mandatory for such organizations to disclose information related to allegations of corruption and human rights violations.
- Section 8(1) provides an exemption from disclosure of such information,
 the disclosure of which
 - Is likely to adversely affect the sovereignty and integrity of India.
 - There is contempt of court or violation of privilege of Parliament etc.
