- The Central Government has issued a notification regarding the Rani Durgavati Tiger Reserve located in the Damoh district of Madhya Pradesh.
- After merging with Nauradehi Sanctuary, it has become the largest tiger reserve in Madhya Pradesh.

## **Veerangana Durgavati Tiger Reserve -**

- It is the 7th tiger reserve of Madhya Pradesh and the 54th of India.
- Notification :- 22 September 2023
- Included sanctuary Nauradehi (Sagar) & Rani Durgavati (Damoh)
- District: Sagar, Damoh and Narsinghpur Total Area :- 141400.860 hectares














- Project Tiger-
  - Beginning :- 1 April 1973
  - During the tenure of the then Prime Minister Indira Gandhi
  - First Tiger Reserve of India (1973):- Jim Corbett (Ramganga), Uttarakhand
  - First Tiger Reserve of Madhya Pradesh (1974):- Kanha Kisli
  - Along with having the highest number of tigers (785) in the country,

Madhya Pradesh also has the highest number of tiger reserves.

- It is caused by monkeypox virus belonging to the Orthopoxvirus genus.

- Monkeypox is a zoonotic disease.
- The natural source of this virus is unknown.
- This virus is mostly spread by small mammals like squirrels and monkeys.
- Transmission of Mpox can occur from one person to another through direct contact with infected skin or other lesions.
- Its first case was found in 1958.




















- The Central Government has taken a big decision regarding Ayushman Bharat Scheme.
- The Union Health Ministry has sent a letter to the states and union territories to implement it.
- They have been established to provide various types of health services.
- These include health services other than maternal and child health care services.
- Its tagline will be- 'Aarogyam Param Dhanam'.
- After the government's decision, the names of Ayushman Bharat-Health and Wellness Centers in the states will be changed.
- These include non-communicable diseases, palliative & corrective care; Oral &
- ENT Care; Provides mental health care & primary care in cases of emergencies & trauma.
- Now the name of these centers in the states and union territories will be changed to Ayushman Arogya Mandir.
- AB-HWCs were launched under the Ayushman Bharat program in 2018. There are more than 1.6 lakh such centers across the country.
