- The first queen to fight against the British colonial rule in India.
- Died. December 25, 1796
- Became her husband's successor in the year 1780.
- In the year 1780, there was an alliance with Hyder Ali and Gopal Naykar against the British.

- Before this, he last became a member of the Statistics Commission in the year 2004.

- Established: 1947
- **Headquarters:** New York
- It is the supreme body of the global statistical system.
- It brings together chief statisticians from member states around the world.
- It is the highest decision-making body for international statistical activities.
- Structure:
- Member Countries 24
- Tenure: 4 years of members Members are elected by the United Nations Economic and Social Council.













- Pattern :
- Five members from African states.
- Four members from Asia-Pacific states.
- Four members from Eastern European states.
- Four members from Latin American and Caribbean states.
- Seven members from Western Europe and other states.
