





Global Resource Outlook 202

- The Global Resource Outlook 2024 was launched on the final day of the Sixth United Nations Environment Assembly at the UNEP Headquarters in Nairobi, Kenya.
- This year's report highlights how resources are essential for the effective implementation of Agenda 2030 and multilateral environmental agreements to tackle the triple planetary crisis.
- It brings together the best available data, modeling, and assessments from 180 countries, seven world regions, and four income groups to analyze trends, impacts, and distributional impacts of resource use.





















Key Points

- It presents a stark picture of global inequality, where low-income countries consume six times less material than rich countries despite producing 10 times less climate impact.
- Global production and consumption of material resources has more than tripled over the past 50 years, growing at an average rate of more than 2.3 percent per year.
- Resource consumption and use is largely driven by demand in high-income countries.
- Extraction and processing of physical resources—including fossil fuels, minerals, nonmetallic minerals, and biomass—accounts for more than 55 percent of greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and 40 percent of particulate matter toxics to the environment.
- The extraction and processing of crops and forestry products is responsible for 90 percent of land-related biodiversity loss and water stress and one-third of GHG emissions.
- The extraction and processing of fossil fuels, metals, and non-metallic minerals including sand, gravel, and clay accounts for 35 percent of global emissions.
- Despite this, resource exploitation may increase by about 60 percent by 2060 from 2020 levels to 100 to 160 billion tons.










INTERNATIONAL Big Cat Alliance

The Union Cabinet formally announced the establishment of the International Big Cat Alliance (IBCA) with a one-time budgetary support of Rs 150 crore from the Central Government till 2028.























key Point

- This is an initiative launched by the Prime Minister of India in Mysore in April 2023 to commemorate the 50th anniversary of Project Tiger.
- IBCA aims to ensure cooperation for the conservation of the seven big cats: lion, tiger, leopard, cheetah, snow leopard, jaguar, and puma. Apart from Jaguar and Puma, five of these cats are found in India.
- Membership: It is open to 97 'range' countries, including the natural habitats of these big cats, as well as other interested nations, international organizations, etc.
 - It aims to facilitate cooperation among countries for mutual benefit in pursuing the conservation agenda.
- It will have a broad base and multidimensional approach in establishing manifold linkages across multiple sectors and will help in knowledge sharing, capacity building, networking, advocacy, finance and resource support, research and technical assistance, education, and awareness.
- It received Rs.100 crore from the Government of India. Has received initial support of Rs 150 crore for five years (2023-24 to 2027-28).










STRUCTURE

- There is a General Assembly, which includes all the member countries.
 - A Council of at least seven but not more than 15 member states and a Secretariat elected by the General Assembly for a term of 5 years.
 - On the recommendation of the Council, the General Assembly will appoint the IBCA Secretary General for a specific term.
