- The Union Ministry of Education has recently launched the registration portal for Phase 3 of Yuva Sangam under Ek Bharat, Shreshtha Bharat (EBSB).
- 20 reputed institutions across India have been identified for Phase
  3 of Yuva Sangam.
- It is based on Kashi Tamil Sangamam.
- Yuva Sangam is an initiative of the Government of India under 'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat'.
- Its objective is to strengthen the interconnectedness among the youth of different states/union territories of India.
- Under this, youth from different states will visit other states for 5-7 days.
- They will be provided with multidimensional experiences under five broad areas – tourism, tradition, progress (development), I nteraction (people-to-people connections) and technology.
- It is inspired by the National Education Policy 2020 and focuses on experiential learning.







## Intra State Transmission **System Green Energy Corridor**























- Cabinet has approved Phase II of InSTS GEC for 13 GW renewable energy project in Ladakh.
- Power Grid Corporation of India Limited will be the implementing agency for this project.
- This project is a new component in addition to Phase II of InSTS GEC.
- It is already under implementation in Gujarat, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu and Uttar Pradesh.
- Through this, a target has been set to achieve grid integration and transmit about 20 GW of renewable electrical energy from the generation plant to the grid.
- The project is expected to be completed by 2026.
