 - The solution is real time observation.
- The problem is that coaching does not know what the problem is
 - The solution is that we have the ability to solve every problem in a different way of every student.
- The problem is that coaching is teacher and teaching focused
 - The solution is that it should be student centered. Who we are.
- The problem is that coaching feels that every student has the same problem.
 - The solution is that in reality, every student may have a completely different problem, the solution is not with coaching, but we have.
- The problem is that coaching does not know what is the difference between a student who passes and who fails.

- Solution While we know what is the difference between them.
- The problem is that coaching cannot evaluate itself (how successful they were in what they did)
 - This is the solution that we can do.

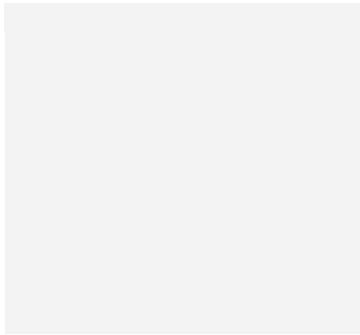

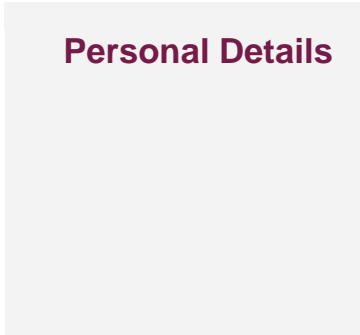
